With excellent skiing and snowboarding (day or night), a free sledding hill, ice skating, and a charming Alpine Village filled with intriguing shops and tempting restaurants, you'll find a winter wonderland of fun for the entire family. Ski Beech features the South's only high-speed, detachable quad lift enabling skiers and snowboarders to make more runs. In warmer months hiking and mountain biking trails offer a glorious glimpse of the High Country's most exhilarating scenery.
