Whether you're here for a visit, or a little longer, you'll find plenty to do throughout all of Richmond County.

Local history is preserved at the Fayetteville Road Historic District in Rockingham, the National Railroad Museum & Hall of Fame in Hamlet and the Rankin Museum of American Heritage in Ellerbe.

The Fayetteville Road Historical District in Rockingham features many older homes which have been restored to their original condition, the Leak Wall House, the Courthouse and the U.S. Federal Building which is now used for county offices.

The Hamlet Depot is a prime example of Victorian architecture and is one of the most photographed stations in the eastern U.S.

The Rankin Museum of American Heritage consists of a diverse collection of natural and cultural history from several continents.

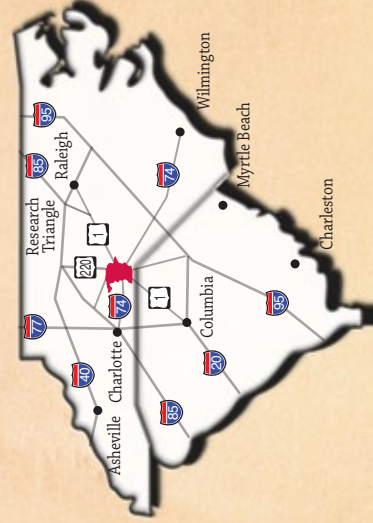
Cartledge Creek Baptist Church, established in 1784, was the site for the third Baptist State Convention where a resolution was passed setting up the Board for Wake Forest University on November 4, 1833.

The Dockery House became a historical monument when on his march through the south, General Sherman and his troops stayed at the Dockery House during the Civil War.

The many historic sites of Richmond County give the area great character and charm.
