LELAND CULTURAL ARTS CENTER

The Leland Cultural Arts Center provides a vibrant hub for the arts in Leland, Brunswick County, and surrounding areas. ODELL WILLIAMSON AUDITORIUM AT BRUNSWICK COMMUNITY COLLEGE

HISTORIC

USS NORTH CAROLINA BATTLESHIP

Moored in quiet dignity and majesty the Battleship NORTH CAROLINA, across the river from downtown Wilmington, beckons visitors to walk her decks. Envision the daily life and fierce combat her crew faced in the Pacific Theatre during World War II.

OLD BALDY

Old Baldy is the oldest standing lighthouse in North Carolina. It has maintained its original form and location for over 187 years. The most important purpose of Old Baldy was to mark the Cape Fear River entrance for the maritime sailors. Bald Head Island is accessible by passenger ferry from Deep Point Marina located at 1301 Ferry Road, Southport, North Carolina.

BRUNSWICK TOWN FORT ANDERSON HISTORIC SITE

A major pre-Revolutionary port on North Carolina's Cape Fear River, Brunswick was razed by British troops in 1776 and was never rebuilt. During the Civil War, Fort Anderson was constructed atop the old village site, and served as part of the Cape Fear River defenses below Wilmington before the fall of the Confederacy. Today, it is one of North Carolina's state historic sites and a working archaeological site.
